Conditional Flight Control System

▣ QUICK CONDITIONAL OVERVIEW

ZERO CONDITIONAL If you heat ice, it melts.	FIRST CONDITIONAL If you study, you will improve.
SECOND CONDITIONAL If I were rich, I would buy a jet.	THIRD CONDITIONAL If I had studied, I would have passed.

▣ ZERO CONDITIONAL = GENERAL TRUTH

Formula:

If + present simple, present simple

Examples:

- If passengers arrive late, they miss the flight.
- If students practice English, they improve.

▣ FIRST CONDITIONAL = REAL FUTURE POSSIBILITY

Formula:

If + present simple, will + base verb

Examples:

- If you study English, you will improve quickly.
- If the weather gets worse, the flight will be delayed.

□ SECOND CONDITIONAL = IMAGINARY

Formula:

If + past simple, would + base verb

Examples:

- If I were rich, I would buy a private jet.
- If Rico owned an airline, he would fly everywhere for free.

□ THIRD CONDITIONAL = UNREAL PAST

Formula:

If + past perfect, would have + past participle

Examples:

- If I had studied harder, I would have passed.
- If we had left earlier, we would have caught the flight.

□ CABIN EXCHANGE

Victor:

I would create luxury international flights.

Rico:

Yo, if I were CEO, every passenger would get VIP runway treatment.
